WHEREAS, Michigan Indian Tuition Waiver Initiative (MITW) is appropriated through the Michigan Legislature and implemented through the Michigan Colleges and Universities; and

WHEREAS, the initiative has been under funded for the Colleges and Universities that have the highest participation in educating our students; and

WHEREAS, it has been established that MITW initiative has been the most successful means of providing the opportunity to prepare Michigan's first citizens for a better quality of life for their families and communities,

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the federally recognized Tribes of Michigan strongly support the Colleges and Universities of Michigan in their efforts to fully fund this initiative as determined by the Michigan Legislature.
